Dear Prospective Kinship/Relative/Foster/Adoptive Parents:

Attached you will find the current PRIDE Pre-Service Training schedule. PRIDE stands for Parent Resources for Information, Development, and Education.

We would like to take this opportunity to explain that PRIDE Pre-Service Training is **not** a 'parenting class.' PRIDE is designed to strengthen the quality of kinship/foster care and adoption services by developing and supporting resource (kinship/foster/adoptive) families as partners in child protection. As a model of practice, PRIDE provides preparation, assessment, and ongoing professional development, support and retention.

PRIDE Pre-Service Training consists of 4 Saturdays (2 sessions each day) or 8 Tuesdays (1 session each evening). The first session, known as "orientation" will cover the Home Finding Policy of the West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources, presented by a Home Finding Specialist and is mandatory for all to attend. The Home Finding Specialist will return on the final day of PRIDE for a 'panel session' to wrap up the training and answer any questions that you may have. You will receive a certificate from the PRIDE trainer to verify that you have completed all of the PRIDE Pre-Service Training sessions. Please submit a copy of the certificate to your WV DHHR Home Finding Specialist.

To register: complete the form for the PRIDE training you wish to attend. You may attend training at any location (does not have to be the county you reside in). Please include your name(s), telephone number(s) and e-mail address. Promptly return to your Home Finding Specialist. There are 25 seats available for each location. It is important to get registered as soon as possible!
